

Orca1 Cookies & Tracking Notice

This Cookies & Tracking Notice explains how Orca1 uses cookies and similar tracking technologies to recognize you when you visit our website. It explains what these technologies are and why we use them, as well as your rights to control our use of them.

1. What are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used by website owners in order to make their websites work, or to work more efficiently, as well as to provide reporting information.

2. Scope of Tracking

This notice applies to the Orca1 Website scope, which includes our public-facing web pages and dashboards.

- **Website:** We use cookies and web-tracking provisions to analyze traffic and provide a seamless user experience.
- **API/SDK:** For users interacting via the Orca1 API or SDKs, cookies are **not** used. Authentication for these services relies on headers and secure tokens rather than browser-based tracking.

3. Usage Data Collection

When you access the Orca1 service, we may collect certain information automatically, including:

- Internet Protocol (IP) address
- Browser type and version
- Pages visited and time spent on those pages
- Unique device identifiers and diagnostic data
- Mobile device information (if applicable), such as device ID and operating system

4. Tracking Technologies Used

We use the following technologies to track activity and store information:

- **Cookies or Browser Cookies:** Small files placed on your device. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies; however, some parts of our Service may not function correctly without

them.

- **Web Beacons:** Small electronic files (also known as clear gifs or pixel tags) that permit Orca1 to count users who have visited specific pages or opened emails for website statistics and performance monitoring.

5. Types of Cookies We Use

We use both **Session** and **Persistent** cookies for the purposes outlined below:

Cookie Type	Persistence	Administered By	Purpose
Necessary / Essential	Session	Orca1	Essential to provide services available through the Website and to enable secure features like user authentication and fraud prevention.
Notice Acceptance	Persistent	Orca1	Identifies if users have accepted the use of cookies on the Website to prevent repeated prompts.
Functionality	Persistent	Orca1	Allows the Website to remember choices you make (such as login details or language preferences) to provide a personalized experience.

6. Managing Your Cookie Preferences

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings. You can:

- Delete all cookies from your device.
- Block all cookies.
- Set the browser to notify you before a cookie is stored.

Please note that if you choose to reject cookies, you may still use our website, though your access to some functionality and areas of our website may be restricted.
